You Are Being Tested

I have never really enjoyed tests! It matters not if it is a written test, eye test, hearing test, check-up test, blood tests, driving test, psychological test ... tests, tests, and more tests. However, they are part of life. And how you perform on the *spiritual tests* will determine your results and reactions to all other tests in life!

Mark it down: You who are reading this are being TESTED!

It may deal with relationships, circumstances of all kinds, emotional challenges, or physical issues, but you are being tested! You may even be in a 'spiritual battle.' The question is: Do you possess the confidence of Job when he was being tested?

"But He knows the way I take and when He has tested me, I will come forth as gold." Job 23:10 NIV

As a believer, God permits tests to develop your character. He wants to increase your faith muscles! He wants clearer focus in your life in order for you to have greater passion and enjoyment. He wants you to have a deeper, richer, and fuller understanding of who He is and what He has promised. There are always 'higher God known' reasons why you are experiencing what you are experiencing!

The question remains: **How are you doing?** You may be responding, "Well, not so good. I am weary, worn-out, and terribly irritable. I am jumpy and fearful. I am really having a tough time!" If that is the case, allow me to suggest a few thoughts for you to consider:

- There are always developing solutions, answers, and sustaining grace occurring behind the scenes. You know God is in charge, loving, and caring, but you do not see it or feel it. However, *you are not without assistance <u>now</u>*. But the focus and attention must be correct and not misdirected. The 'Blame Game' is always in motion and is not the answer. The focus must be God-ward to His *Superintendence* and *Sufficiency*. Tests are always opportunities to get nearer to Jesus. <u>Right Focus</u> with <u>Right Facts</u> equals <u>Right Feelings</u> in the midst of unresolved and unchanged issues.
- 2. The testing is to prove and demonstrate His strength and provision for and through you. Its main purpose is not to demean you as a person, but to show His worth in meeting your need, hurt, want, or desire. You cannot even generate a solution for the problem. He resources, guides, and blesses and ... *at times ... in His timing* ... in a miraculous way! He may use your giftedness and skills like Bezalel, son of Uri, and Aholiab, son of Ahisamach (Building of Tabernacle) in the Old Testament, but they were energized by Jehovah.
- 3. A time of testing is always a time for His people to THINK! We have lost the "Art of Lingering." We are so in a hurry, rush, and "must do" that we lose what Mary had discovered ... 'lingering at the feet of Jesus' (Luke 10). Lingering allows you to 'listen' and 'learn' and then you can really 'live!' We live 'hurricane lives' and generate 'hurricane messes!' "Junk and stuff" and "destruction and turmoil" are everywhere! No wonder we do not feel good!!
- 4. Preparation for fuller, wider, richer, and deeper usefulness is occurring. Reflect on these words: "All of the Lord's true people will at last be 'presented faultless' before the heavenly throne; but do we thereby conclude that all will be alike in traits of character? <u>No, the</u>

experiences of this present life affect in our character something which will persist into the Beyond. It may well be that the hardest suffering here is leading to the highest ministry there." (Sidlow Baxter (Awake My Heart)

Something great is happening to you in problems, pains, disappointments, and troubles. Don't let the whiners, critics, bullies, gossipers, and overall pessimists get to you! You are on God's Mission!!
