But Jesus ...

As I was on a journey through Hebrews, I came to chapter 7. It deals with Melchizedek, priest of the Most High God, the Levitical Priesthood, and Jesus, 'who remains forever a priest, He holds His priesthood permanently' (7:24 HCSB). The writer states:

"But because He remains forever, He holds His priesthood permanently. Therefore, He is **always able** to save those who come to God through Him, since **He always lives to** *intercede for them.*" Hebrews 7:24-25 HCSB

And then you see a statement in the next chapter that *leaps from the page:*

"<u>But Jesus</u> has now obtained a <u>superior ministry</u>, and to that degree <u>He is the mediator</u> of a **better covenant** which has been legally enacted on **better promises**." Hebrews 8:6 HCSB

But Jesus ... I immediately proceeded to discover how many '*But Jesus*' expressions were found in the New Testament. The expression or meaningful similar statement was found 144 times. It occurs in teachings to man, the trials of man, thoughts revealed within man, and challenges for man. So Simple ... so Clear ... so Concise!

Jesus will never disappoint, never be late, never register as unavailable, or never be unconcerned about what you are thinking, feeling, or doing. *Jesus will always tell you the truth.* There will be 'private agendas, smoke screens, or ulterior motives in, from, and around man,' but He will be true! Where could we find such a person?

He is God in the flesh. He is the manifestation of the God head in bodily form. When you see Jesus, you see God. He said to Philip, "... The one who has seen Me has seen the Father..." (John 14:9 HCSB). When you 'see Jesus' in the Gospels, you see God ... the God Man! The Father lives in Jesus. And God the Holy Spirit makes all this real ... the mystery of the Triune God!

But Jesus ... He is our Shepherd, our Redeemer, our Liberator, and our Coming King! As the verses above point out, *He is always able and He always lives to intercede for us with a superior ministry.*

Preach and study all the '**But Jesus**' expressions in the New Testament! This will lift your spirit, control your thinking, and pace your labor. For starters, there are 19 in Matthew. Take copious notes and write your book on what you discover! I am ready to hand it out!!

When Jesus is consulted FIRST in prayer, your life will change. You will think better, look better, and feel better. And you will work better. We must be 'looking to Jesus <u>first</u>.' The warning is given:

"<u>No creature is hidden from Him</u>, **but all things are naked and exposed to the eyes of Him** to whom we must give an account." Hebrews 4:13

He is looking and He will be asking: *Did you do your best for Me*? There is no wiggle room. The accounting will occur! **But Jesus** ...

Jesus is our HOPE!
