## Exploring the Universe of Knowledge with the Faculty at Trinity College of Florida

Completing now our 33<sup>rd</sup> year, the University Center is pleased to announce a unique 2021 course: "Darwinism and Intelligent Design." This course is designed for the general public, including high school students, and is taught on five Thursday nights, March 25-April 22, 6:00 to 9:45 pm Eastern Time. You are invited to study the intersection of science, worldviews and history, as our class, taught jointly with Trinity's Quest Program for degree completion, analyzes Darwinism's history, including its mounting challenges from many fields of biology. Topics include "The Fossil Enigma" and "DNA's Challenge." Contributions by scientists within the Intelligent Design Movement are highlighted.

The course is to be taught, beginning March 29<sup>th</sup>, for five consecutive Thursday nights, at the main campus (2430 Welbilt Blvd., Trinity, FL 34655). The class is also accessible through a live "virtual" video feed. The course professor, Dr. Thomas Woodward, is widely recognized as an historian of the controversy over Darwinism, with three published books on the topic. The class will be joined through live video by Dr. John Lennox (in a noon "Prequel Webinar" on March 18<sup>th</sup>), and also by Dr. Stephen Meyer, Dr. Michael Behe, and Dr. Jonathan Wells. All four Webinars in the course are jointly sponsored by the C.S. Lewis Society.
