- → The ABHE Reaccreditation Final Report has been finalized, submitted, and acknowledged. An onsite visit of ABHE accreditors occurred before the summer. Once approved, the college will be accredited for another 10 years. Regional and National Accreditation are considered equal partners in excellence by the U.S. Department of Education.
- ➤ COVID-19 Issues continue to be a part of the challenges this semester. New guidelines have been reinstated that involve masks and distancing.
