Historically Speaking

The school was founded in 1932 under the leadership of the present president, Dr. William T. Watson. The purpose of the school is the train-

ing of young men and women for definite Christian Work.

The Florida Bible Institute was located in Temple Terrace, near Tampa, for the first eleven years. In the spring of 1943 the officials of the school sold the property in Temple Terrace and purchased a new home for the Institute in St. Petersburg, the new location having many advantages over the former school home.

Trinity College is now in the nineteenth year of "Training for Christian Service," with graduates and former students eminently successfully serving as pastors, evangelists, missionaries, singers and musicians church secretaries, chaplains, youth workers and radio artists. They are serving in all the major denominationa and some in interdenominational churches. Their accomplishments in their fields of service reflect the thorough work done in the classrooms at the school.

Trinity College is the enlarged school and curriculum of the Florida Bible Institute. This change was necessary to meet the urgent request for college work that the students might have additional subjects and courses not offered in regular Bible Institutes, also to provide Bible College work for young people who appreciate a Christian atmosphere where their faith will be strengthened and spiritual values emphasized. The objective of Trinity College will always be "Training for Christian Service." We shall always major in Christian Education.

Trinity College is inter-denominational, fundamental and evangelical. The statement of doctrine is the same as that of "The World's Christian Fundamentals Association." Graduates of the School usually continue their ministry or work in the denomination to which they belong. This they are encouraged to do. Students are taught the value of spiritual things and are encouraged in their "faith life." Prayer is an important part of the school life.

The growing number of students who wish to attend the school has necessitated once more the moving of the school to a more advantageous location at Belleair, Florida. This new location will also place the students in a position to do more extension work, which is an important part of the curriculum.

Ballast Point Evening Class



One of the Trinity College evening classes meets every Friday for two hours at Ballast Point Baptist Church and is being taught by Rev. Calvin Thorpe and Rev. D. Luttrull, Sr. Althought the class is small the students are enjoying the work and are receiving great blessing from the effort they put forth.

7ampa Evening Class



The Tampa Evening Class meets every Monday at the Faith Chruch in Tampa under the leadership of Rev. F. L. Aughinbaugh and Dr. E. C. Bragg. Much good is being accomplished in this class and the quality of the students is high. We praise the Lord for the faithfulness and initative of our evening classes.
