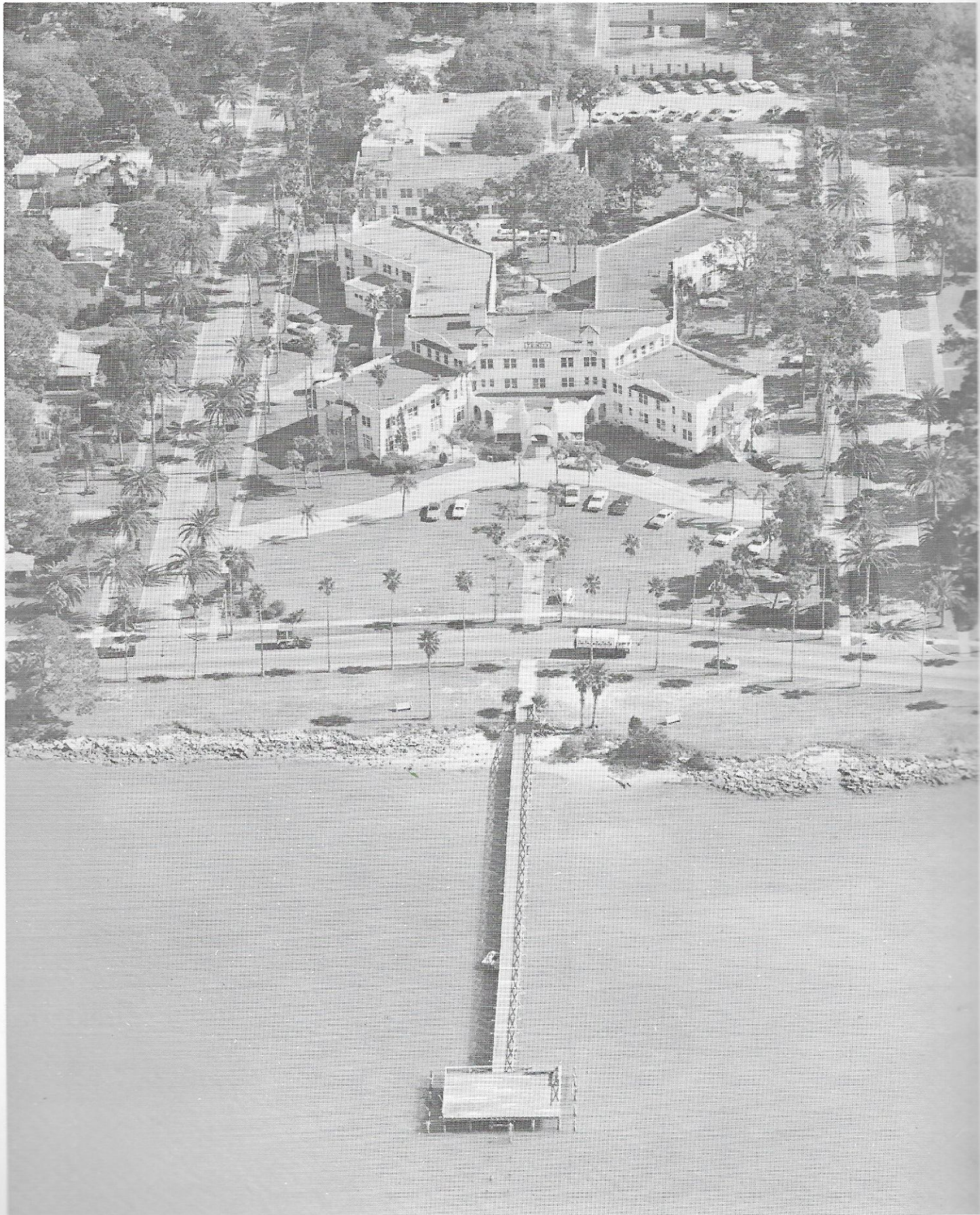

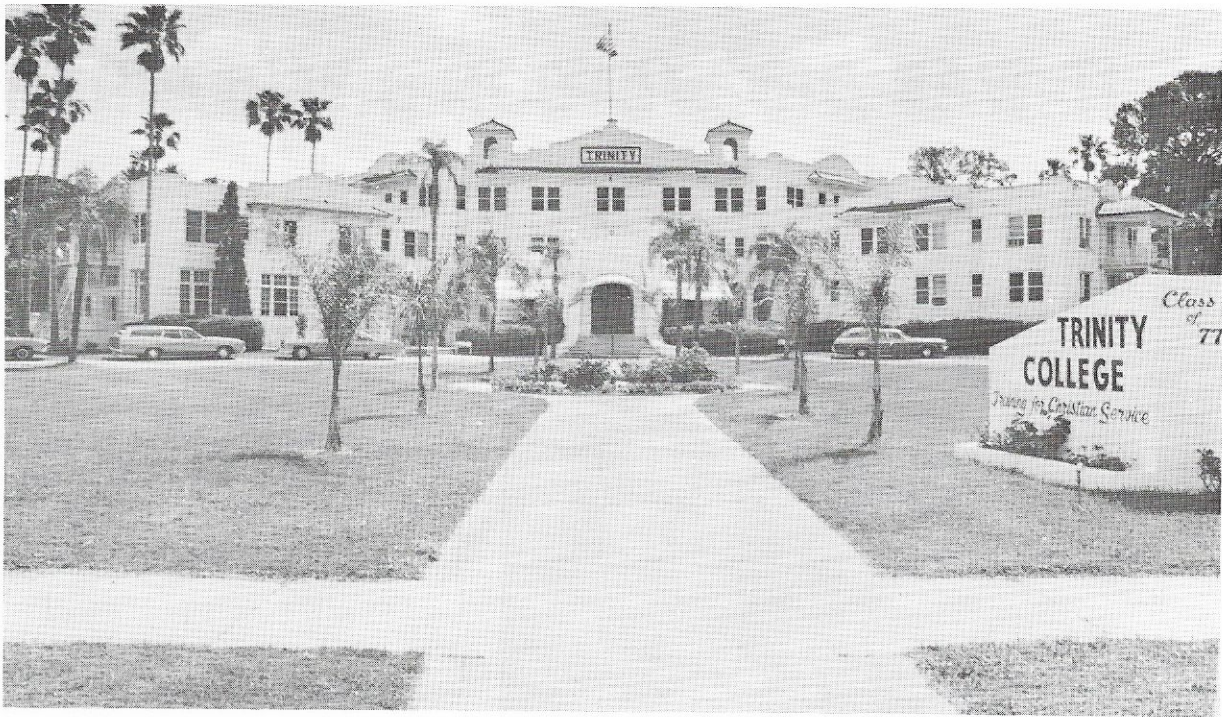






Aerial view of Trinity, Dunedin Campus.



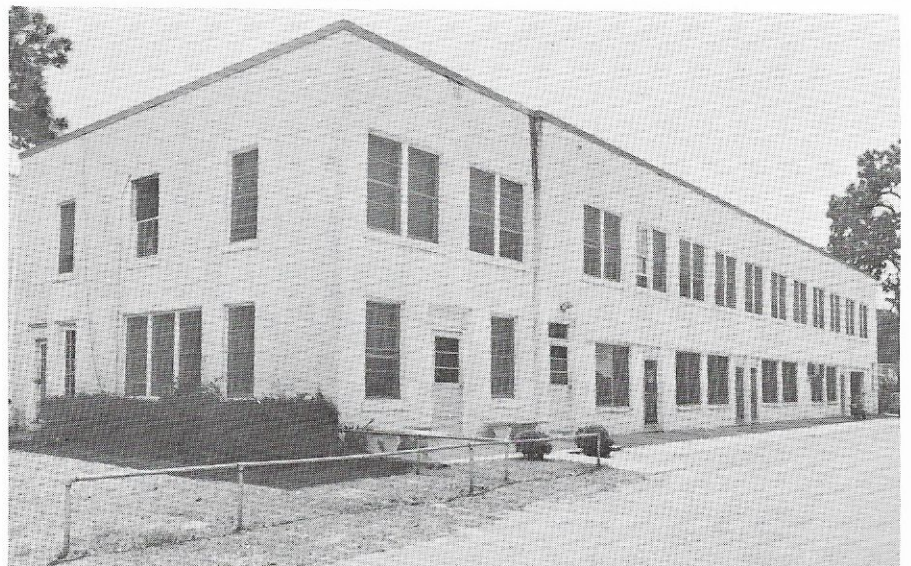


**TOP -** When Trinity purchased this building in 1960 it was the exclusive resort Hotel Fenway.



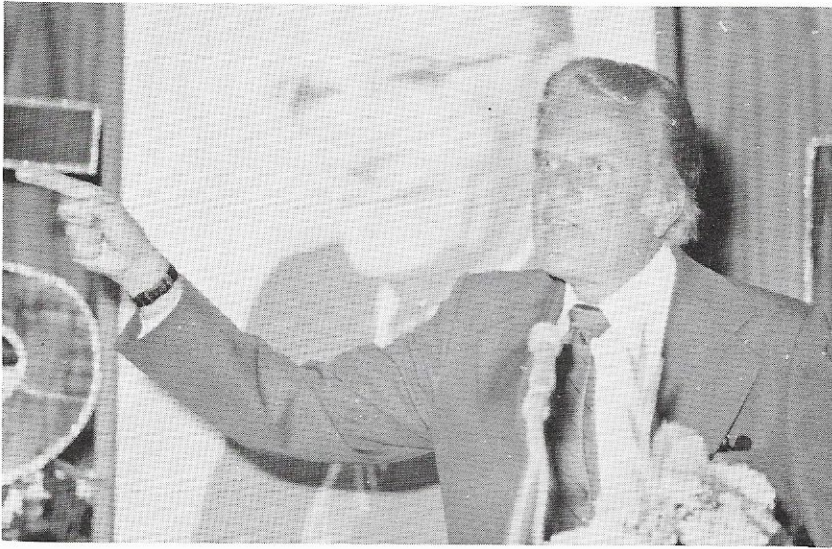

## PROCLAMATIONS FROM MAYORS

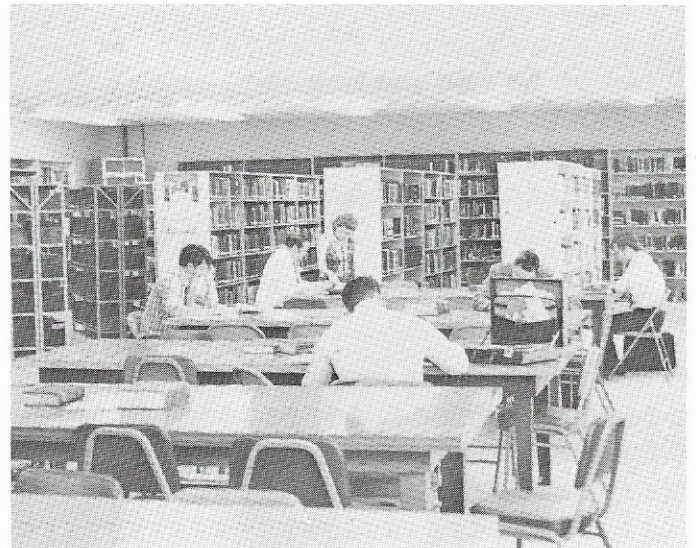

**Above - Patio court and stairway to Trinity's modern air-conditioned library which was recently enlarged.**



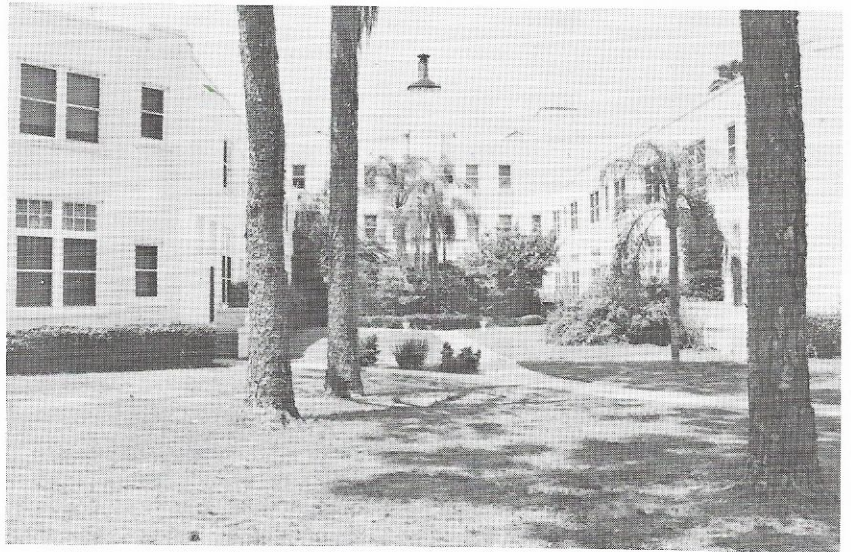

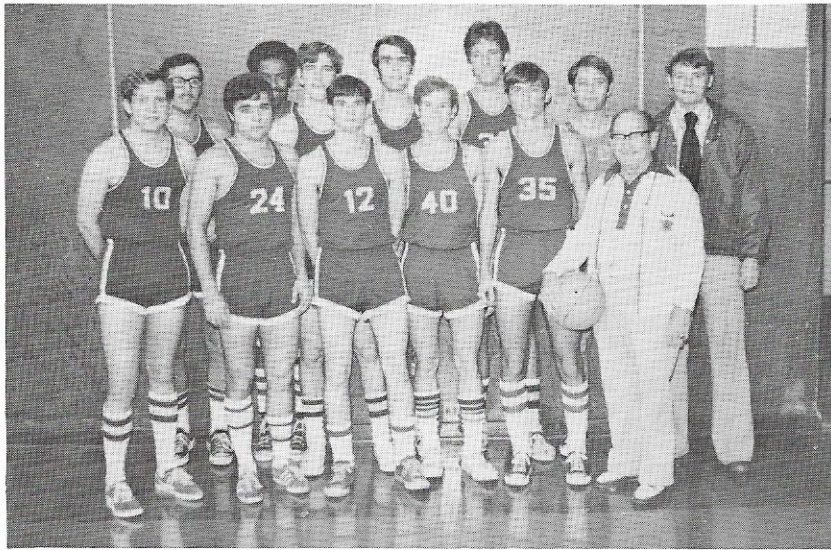

### **ATHLETICS**

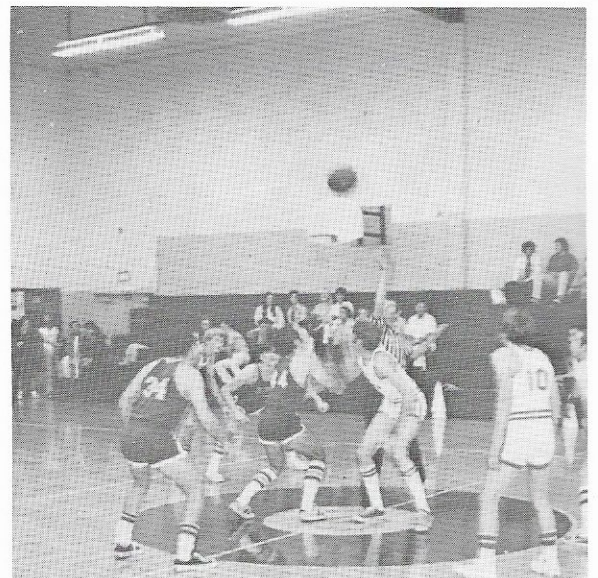

# THE WORD OF GOD



Throughout the ages man has found that the only secure thing he can grasp is the Word of God. God's Word has withstood the test of man and time. It has been a comfort to the distraught soul in the time of trouble; it has brought encouragement to a defeated and frustrated people; it has inspired men to accomplish great things for God and their country.

We here at Trinity are thankful for a college that centers its educational program around the Word of God. Through the experiences of our spiritual life at school we come to better understand and love the word that God has given us.

We realize that "the word of the Lord endureth forever". We need never fear that it is outmoded or obsolete. We can depend upon it to guide our feet as the Psalmist has written, "Thy word is a lamp unto my feet, and a light unto my path." Ps. 119:105.

As Christians we feed upon the word and exclaim "How sweet are thy words unto my taste! yea sweeter than honey to my mouth." Ps. 119:103. As we taste and see how sweet it is, our appetites grow and we are drawn closer to God through His word.

It is important never to forget that the great salvation we have and the story of the love of God for us is recorded only in His Word. We should never be ashamed of God's Word, but state as the Apostle Paul wrote in Romans 1:16, "For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ: for it is the power of God to everyone that believeth; to the Jew first and also to the Greek."



# STATEMENT OF FAITH

1. We believe the Scriptures of the Old and New Testament as verbally inspired by God, and inerrant in the original writings, and that they are the supreme and final authority in faith and life.

2. We believe in one God, eternally existing in three persons, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.

3. We believe that Jesus Christ was begotten of the Holy Spirit and born of the Virgin Mary and is true God and true man.

4. We believe that man was created in the image of God, that he sinned and thereby incurred not only physical death but also that spiritual death which is separation from God.

5. We believe that the Lord Jesus Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures as a representative and substitutionary sacrifice; and that all that believe in Him are justified on the ground of His shed blood.

6. We believe in the resurrection of the crucified body of our Lord, in His ascension into Heaven, and His present life there for us, as High Priest and Advocate.

7. We believe in "that blessed hope," the personal premillennial and imminent return of our Lord and Saviour, Jesus Christ.

8. We believe in the bodily resurrection of the just and the unjust, the everlasting felicity of the saved and the everlasting conscious suffering of the lost.

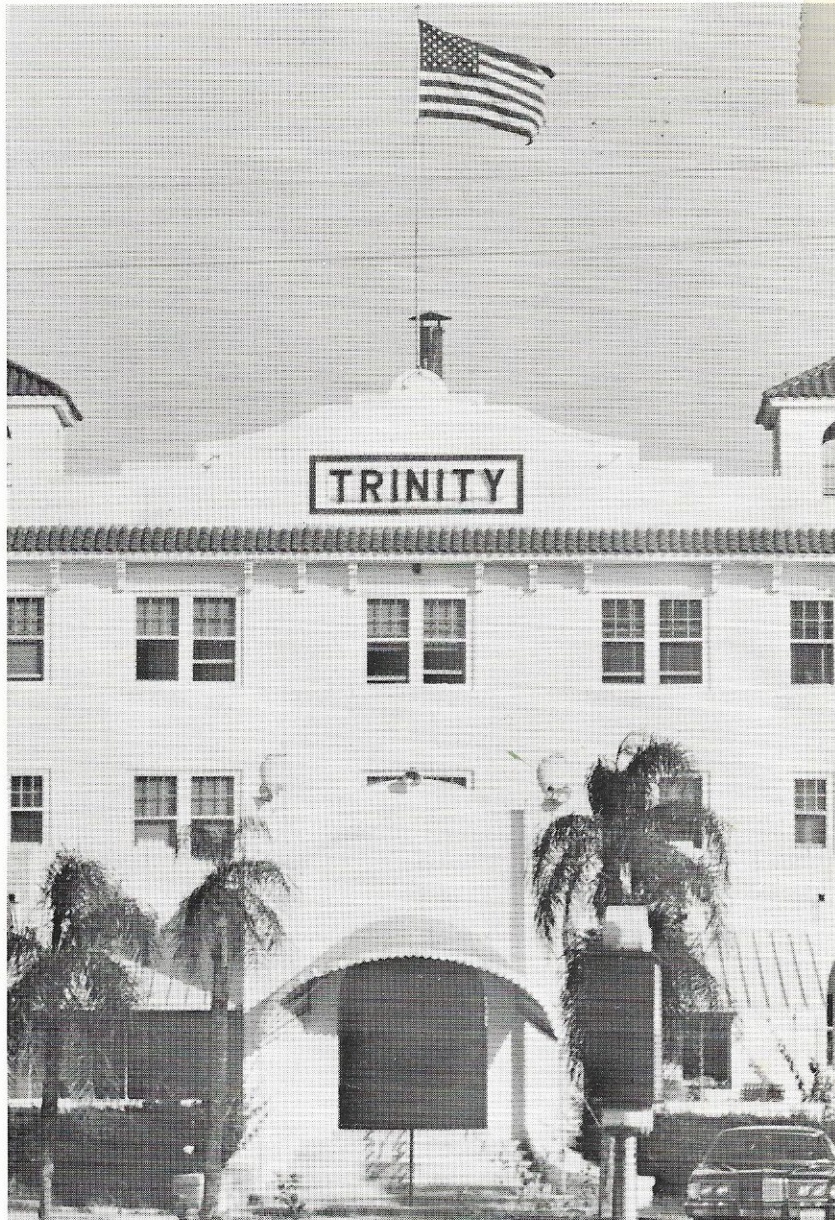
