STATEMENT OF FAITH

1. We believe the Scriptures of the Old and New Testament as verbally inspired by God, and inerrant in the original writings, and that they are the supreme and final authority in faith and life.

8. We believe in the bodily resurrection of the just and the unjust, the everlasting felicity of the saved and the everlasting conscious suffering of the lost.

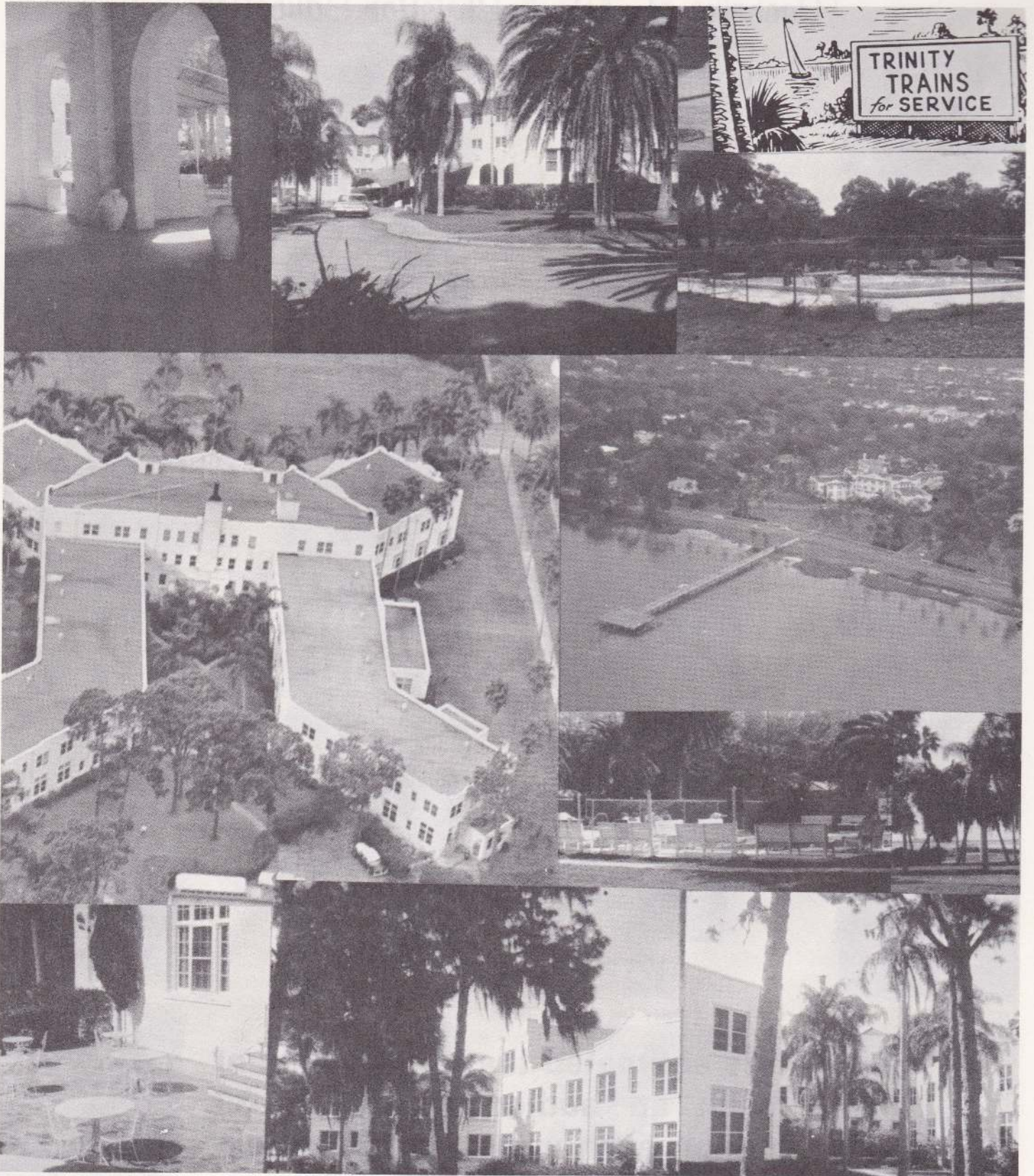
Since 1932 . . .

“Training for Christian Service”

A miracle in Christian Education is the story of Trinity College of Dunedin, Florida. Founded in the days of “the depression (1932) for forty six years has been continuously a “West Point” of Christian training on the West Coast of Florida. It was founded by Dr. W. T. Watson and others seeking to establish in Florida a Bible school to be fundamental and interdenominational, sound in the faith and true to the Word. It was first known as the Florida Bible Institute and later blazed the trail in higher Christian training by becoming a four-year Bible college and the name was changed to “Trinity College.” Other Bible institutes soon followed suit and put in a four-year course and began granting degrees as Trinity was doing.

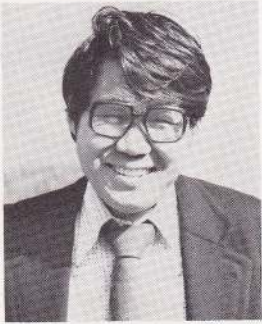
Trinity, through the years, has sought to reach the heart of the student as well as the head. Dr. Watson, and officials of the college there being 18 Board members, feel that the “faith life” of the student must be developed and enlarged. So, the story of Trinity is one of faith. This is well reflected in the Trinity alumni the world over. You will find Trinity trained workers in the front ranks in Christian work at home and abroad. They serve as pastors, evangelists, missionaries, music directors, ministers of youth and music, church secretaries and Christian educators in Bible colleges, seminaries, Liberal Arts educators and instructors in Christian day schools.

Trinity College is NOT for everyone. Only those interested in going into a life of Christian work are encouraged to come to Trinity. Those who are fortunate enough to be “a Trinity College student” will find at Trinity a strong experienced faculty of 21 instructors. The courses are complete and rates are reasonable. Graduates usually are prepared to enter into Christian work immediately upon graduating. Some work scholarships are available. Those interested should write for a free catalog.
