The students are proud to have memories of Dr. E. C. Bragg and Dr. Gary Williams who have truly shown themselves to us and God as workmen "that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth."



Having taught at Trinity College for more than 50 years, Dr. Bragg has always strived to have his teaching empowered by the Holy Spirit.

Best remembered for his Systematic and Pauline Theology classes, Dr. E. C. Bragg has always kept a Christ-centered perspective in his teaching (even though it is rumored that his middle initial stands for "Calvin").

It was once said that Christian Education is to be a servant and not a master of revelation. Without discounting the tremendous help Dr. Williams has been to students expounding the Word, he will be best remembered for his dedication to Christ and his commitment to students. In over 15 years of teaching, he has commuted about 110 miles each day he is here on campus, and has logged over 240,000 miles of driving.

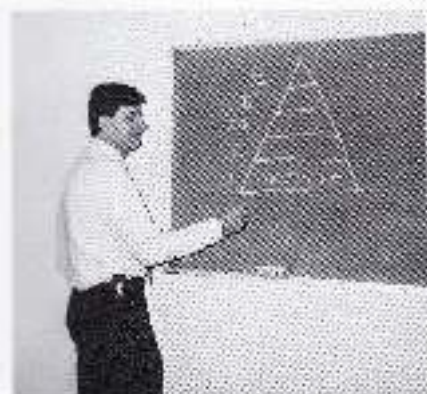

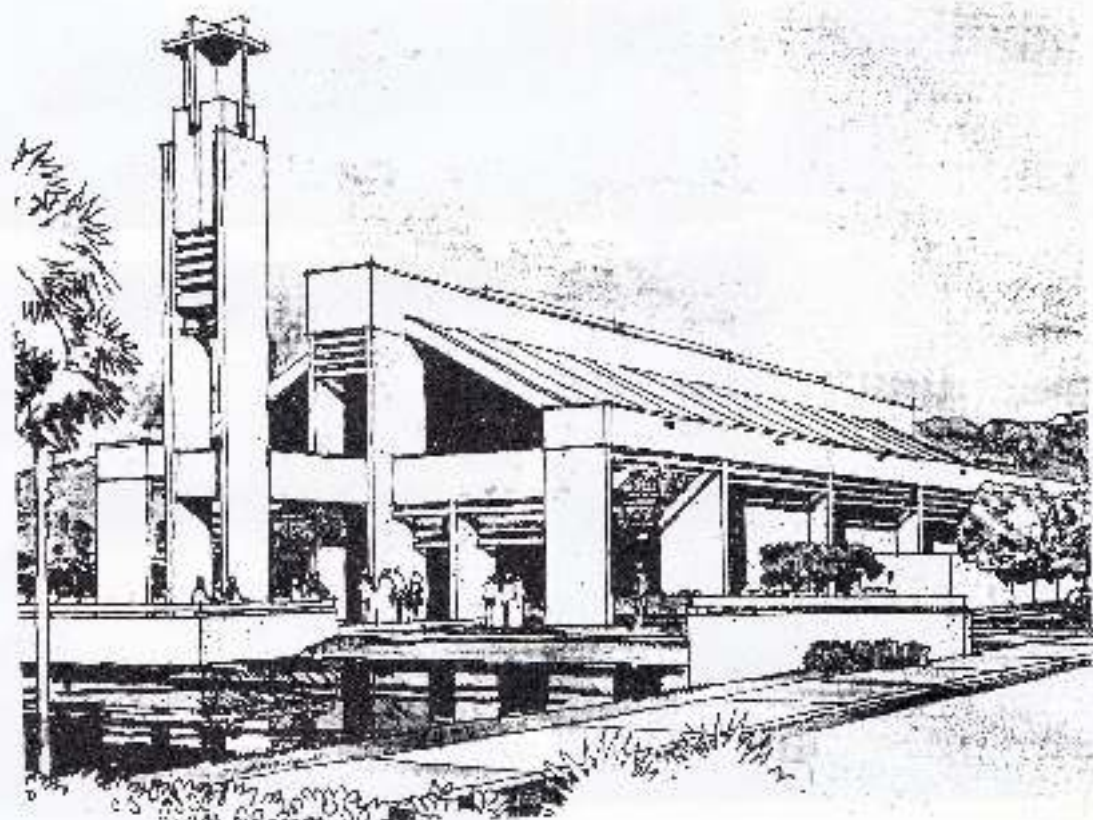

The inaugural service was held at First Baptist Church of Durdin with Dr. John Davis, Trinity Alumnus and President of Grace College and Seminary in Indiana, delivering the keynote address. Dr. Art Yohner, Minister of Missions with Worldteam and Trinity Alumnus and Board Member, gave the charge to the candidate. The prayer of dedication was offered by Dr. E. C. Bragg, Vice-President of Trinity College. The Chairman of the Board of Trustees, Dr. John Rigby, administered the Oath of Office. Mrs. Lucy Watson, Co-founder and First Lady of Trinity, made a floral presentation to Mrs. Banther. Noted dignitaries, including Congressman Michael Bilirakis, extended personal greetings, and Dr. Billy Graham, President of the Class of 1940, sent a telegram of congratulations.

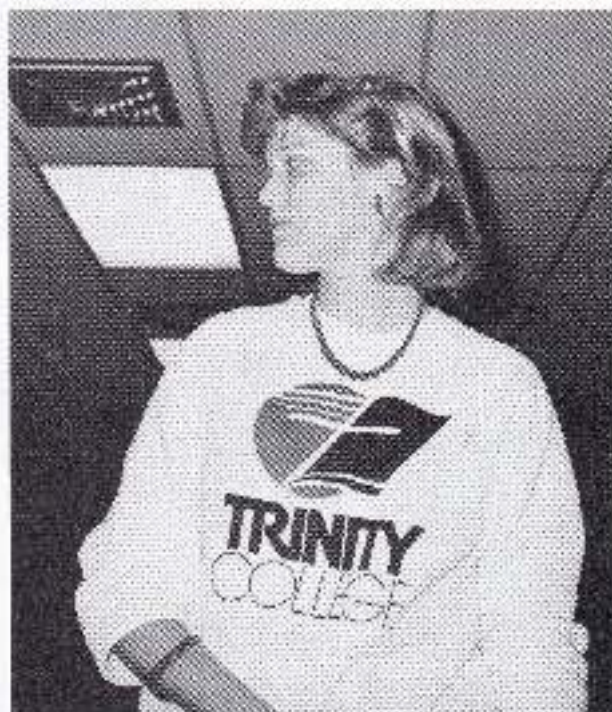




# Yearbook Committee

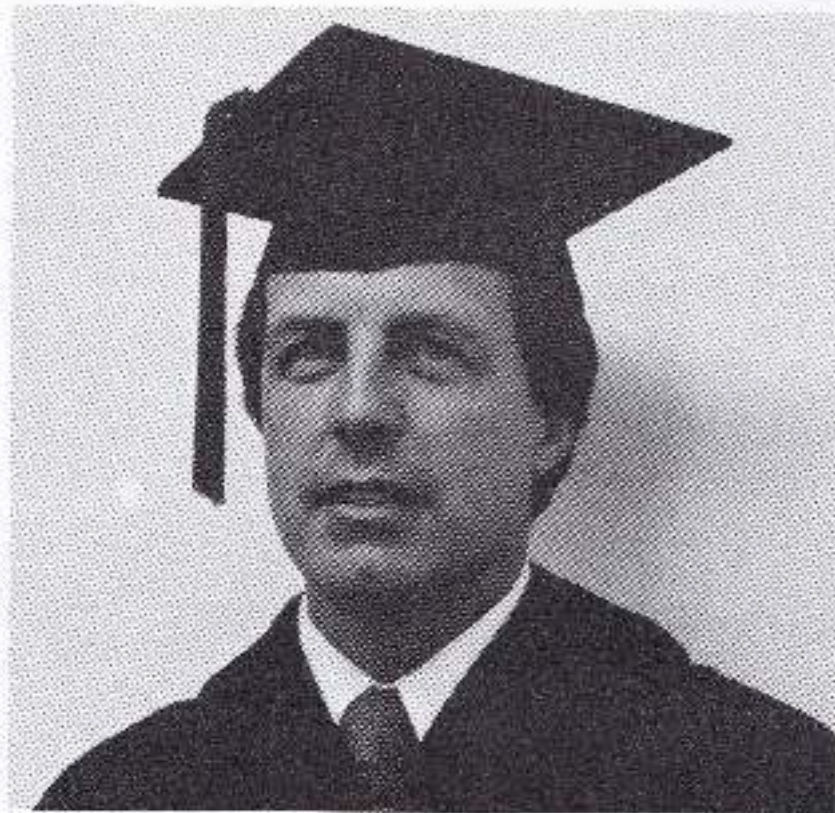
