

Israel's major was Pastoral ministries and it showed up in everything he did. Yes, every now and then you run into to somebody who shines like the stars in the universe (Philippians 2:15). Israel Laing will be missed, but his love for God and his love for God's people will always be remembered. We were blessed to know Israel Laing and his family. He has passed away from this life time; however, we look forward to one day being reunited with him in heaven for all eternity.


Jessica Willis

TRINITY ACADEMICS



scholars only to become preachers." (Spurgeon)


































CHAPEL

"Worthy is the Lamb, who was slain, to receive power and wealth and wisdom and strength and honor and glory and praise (Rev. 5:12)!"









STUDENT GOVERNMENT
