From some unknown resource, these three gathered renewed strength. With a burning desire, they began to put forth that extra effort. The finish line was in sight. It drew closer and closer. First Number One was ahead, then Seven took over with Number Four, close on his heels. They were running full speed now. Pain shot up their legs, their lungs seemed on the verge of bursting. One hundred yards to go. Seven pulled out in front by three yards. He increased it to ten. Sixty yards to go. Eyes were fixed on that white string crossing the track. Ten yards to go, five, four, three, two, one—the winner! Number Seven!
