As we anticipate the spring semester, we wanted to provide an update on the college plans in light of the pandemic. COVID cases throughout the United States are rising and Florida is among those rising dramatically. <u>However, we plan at this time to resume in-class, face to face learning for the spring semester according to the previously posted schedule</u>. We believe that we have the appropriate measures in place to provide a safe learning experience. When you arrive you will be required to answer some diagnostic questions related to your exposure to the virus. This is similar to the procedure we used at the beginning of the fall semester. As always, we will continue to follow CDC recommendations and update our policies to reflect their advice.

Practicing appropriate safety measures will assist us in keeping the spread of the virus low on our campus. 1) Be alert for symptoms. 2) Take your temperature and follow CDC guidance if you have symptoms. 3) If you have symptoms, stay home and alert your supervisor. 4) If you have not been vaccinated, we recommend that you consider getting it and we strongly recommend you wear a mask while indoors on campus to protect yourself. 5) Practice social distancing at all times when possible. 6) Wash your hands often with soap and water.
