- New Academic Offerings coming soon:
  - 1. Shepherds Theological Seminary will begin classes next month, January 2023. Two will be offered leading to master's level degrees.
  - 2. After careful study and review, Trinity will be offering summer classes in 2023. Using the new schedule, students could complete their series of studies at Trinity in 3 ½ years. Classes will begin May 15 (8-week course) with the following included:
    - 3 Weeks of Intensive Classes
    - 5 Weeks of Homework, assignments
    - Live in L.L. Speer Hall with food service
    - Spring Financial Aid will apply
    - Take up to 9 credits
