

# A 'Must' for 2023

Dr. A.B. Simpson, founder of The Christian and Missionary Alliance, wrote this to his constituency in 1886:

And let our service be not our works, but the grace of Christ with us ... Let us learn the meaning of the ministry of prayer ... Let it be a year of deeper, wider, higher, diviner things."

What is the 'MUST' you ask? <u>It is focusing on</u> Jesus! His Person, Work, Teaching, Promises, and Problem Solving! Dr. Sidlow Baxter made this reflection for the New Year:

All four 'unions' are described in John 15:5,15, 20, 27: Union, Communion, toiling, and telling are all found in these spiritual and practical statements of union.

#### Dr. Baxter uses the expressions 'inward fellowship with Christ and a daily useableness by Christ.' May this be the 'MUST' of 2023!

At the Day of Pentecost, empowered by the Holy Spirit, Peter stood up and preached (all were hearing the Gospel in their own language). He focused on this one thought:

"Therefore, let all the house of Israel <u>know</u> <u>assuredly</u> that God has made this Jesus whom you crucified, both **Lord and Christ**." Acts 2:36 NKJV

They were convicted and about three thousand souls were added to the family of God. (Acts 2:41)

With this focus and 'must,' we march forward into 2023 for the Glory and Honor our Lord, the Lord Jesus Christ!

## Did you know:

- The amount of \$210,465 in 375 gifts were given for the Scholarshare program in the past year compared to 369 gifts amounting to \$123,035 received the prior year.
- Stephen Davey, President of Shepherds Theological Seminary, has notified us that the Seminary will be unable to conduct classes on the Trinity campus this semester due to lack of enrollment. Dr. Davey has indicated that Shepherds will gladly consider a Cluster site at Trinity College, which may build interest and perhaps set the stage for another attempt at launching a teaching site in the future.
- Twelve student groups dealing with ministry opportunities and responsibilities have been scheduled for students to attend during the weekly schedule when plenary chapel services are not being held.
- Pasco County Sheriff's Officers have been on campus serving our students with their presence.
- The President will be attending the ABHE Annual Conference February 15-17 with other college personnel. Concentrations on various responsibilities such as student development, enrollment, and finances will be on the schedule.
- Global Impact Missionary Conference is scheduled for February 6-9.
- Campus Preview is set for Monday, February 20. It will be Trinity's first in 2023. Potential students will be on campus for classes and the college experience.
- The President's Council will meet Friday, February 10. The Council is made up of professionals from all fields of life ... business, church, medical, profit and non-profits, and teachers. They provide counsel, insights, and recommendations to the Board of Trustees. Chairman Ed Brandt and Vice Chairman Tom Chapman will be in attendance and addressing the Council. The President will be making a presentation: Sailing the Seas of Life. It will be a review of what the Lord has been doing at Tripity Coll

 Dr. Tom Woodward, Research Professor at Trinity College of Florida and Senior Lecturer with the C. S. Lewis Society has been designated a "Fellow" of Discovery Institute's "Center for Science and Culture." A Princeton graduate in history and Latin American Studies, Dr. Woodward completed his PhD in the Rhetoric of Science at the University of South Florida. His dissertation, titled "Aroused From Dogmatic Slumber: A Rhetorical History of Intelligent Design," positioned him to become an early historian of intelligent design. His thesis work became the basis for his first major book, *Doubts about Darwin: A Rhetorical History of Intelligent Design* (2003), named a

Christianity Today Book of the Year in 2004. He then wrote Darwin Strikes Back: Defending the

*Science of Intelligent Design* (2006), and also coauthored *The Mysterious Epigenome: What Lies Beyond DNA* (2012) with ophthalmologist James Gills.

Restoration Church and a ministry for Chinese Restaurant workers in our area are utilizing the campus. Tuesday and Thursday evenings, Jennifer Bargerhuff, as a Licensed/Registered Mental Health Counselor Intern, has begun providing professional mental health therapy for the students of Trinity College of Florida. Others in the Counseling Department under the leadership of Leslie Rewald are also serving our student body and college family.
