PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

This two-year program expands on the primary core Bible and Theology courses that are foundational and required for all Clarks Summit University programs. It is our belief that knowledge of the Scriptures is essential to a proper education. Therefore, all students take a foundational set of Bible and theology courses.
