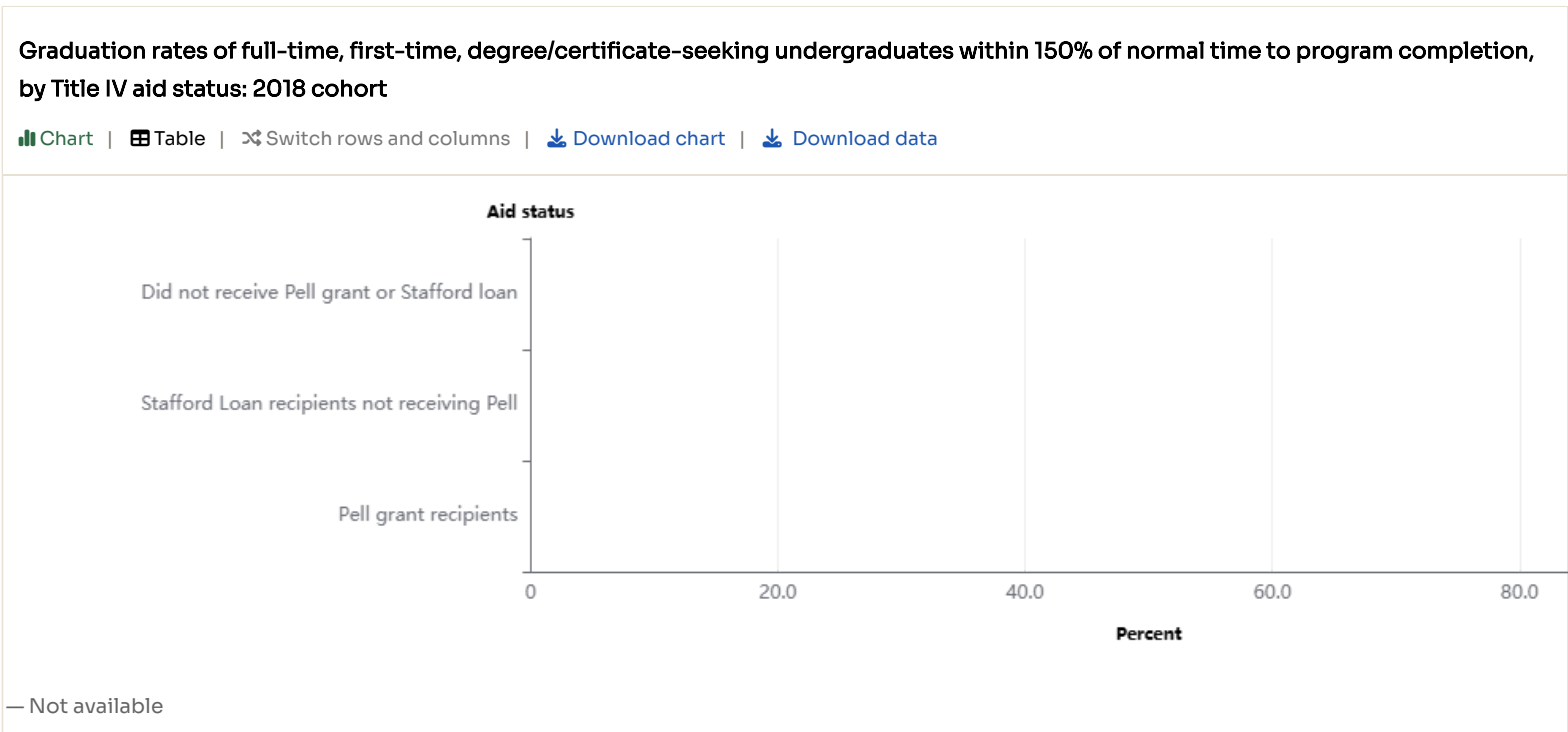

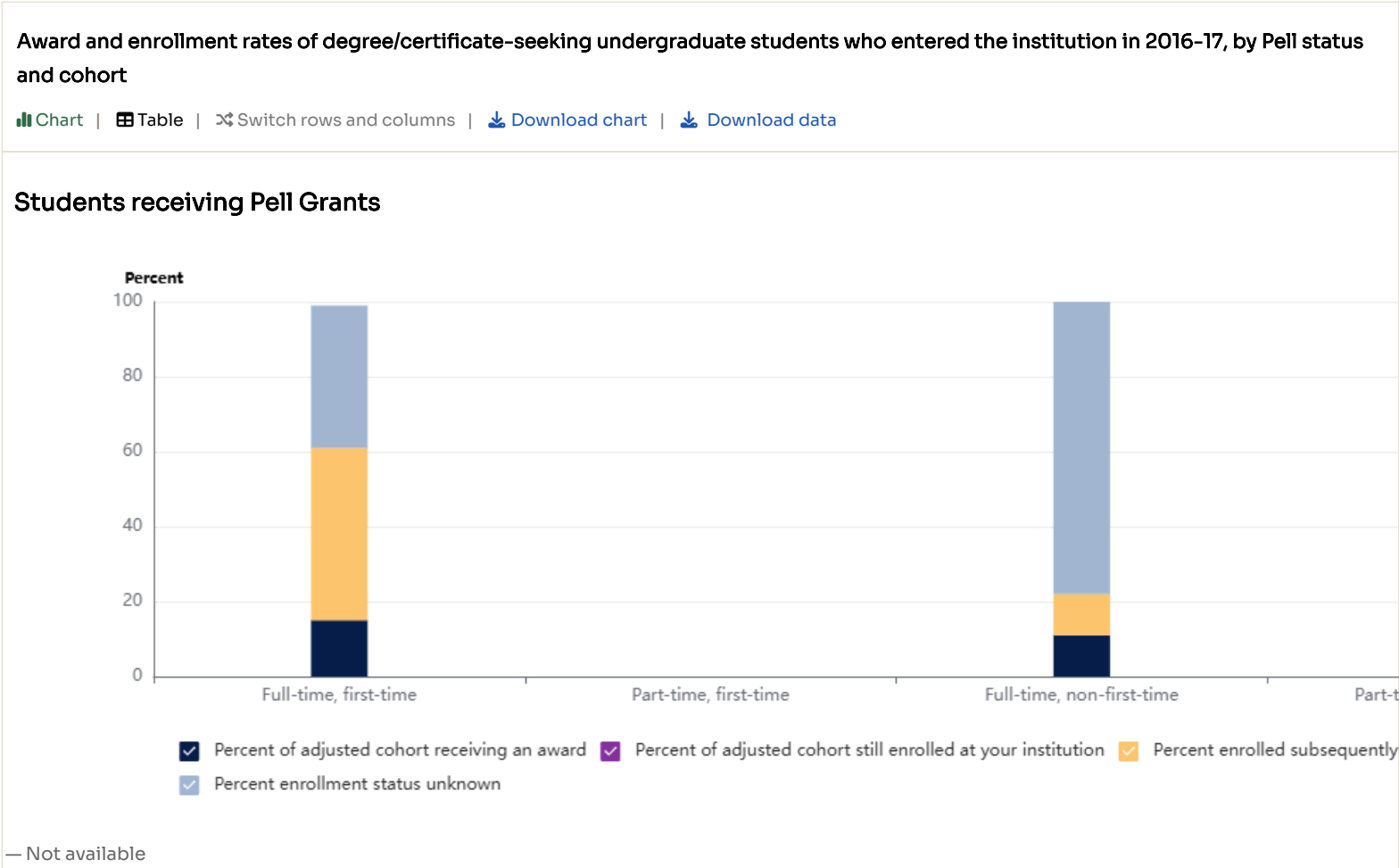

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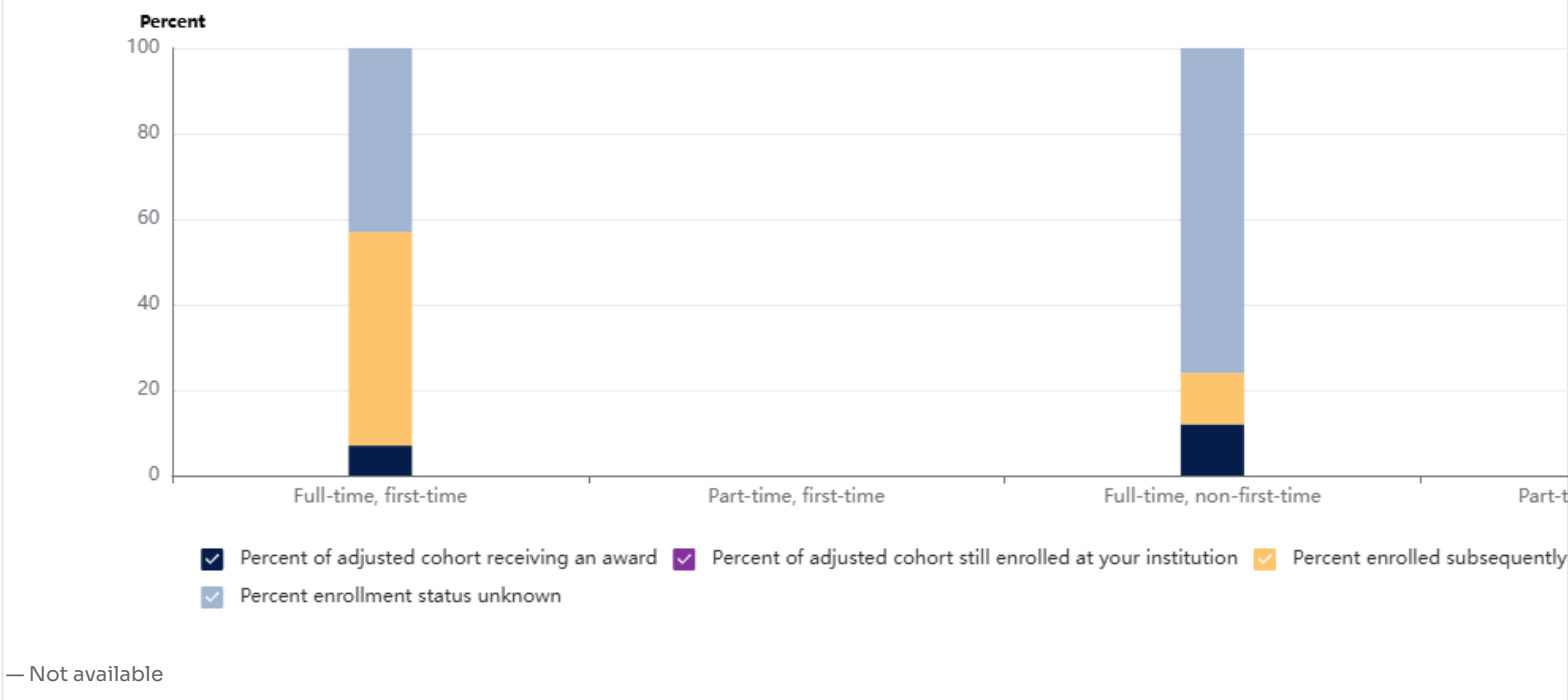

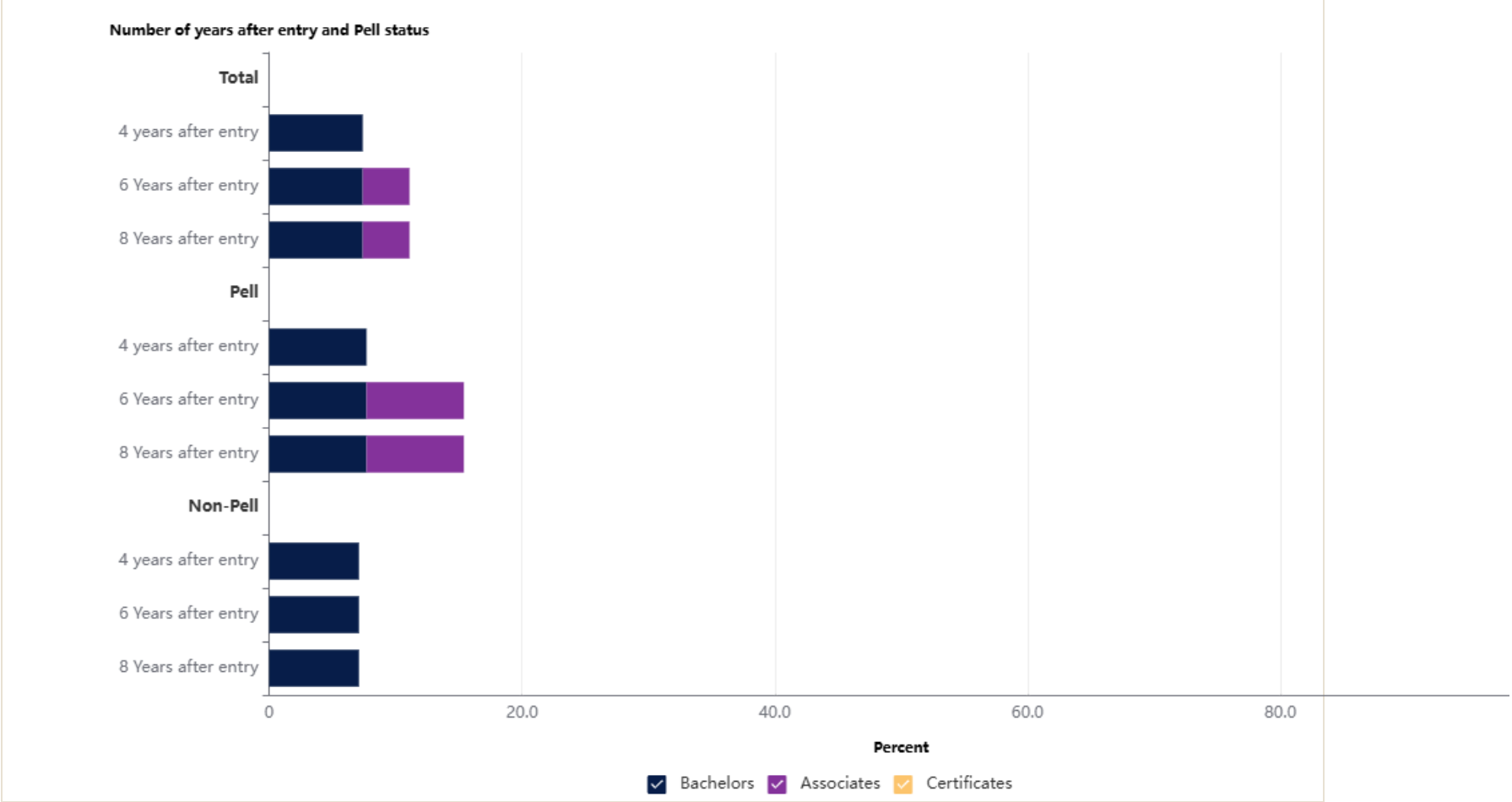


Students not receiving Pell Grants



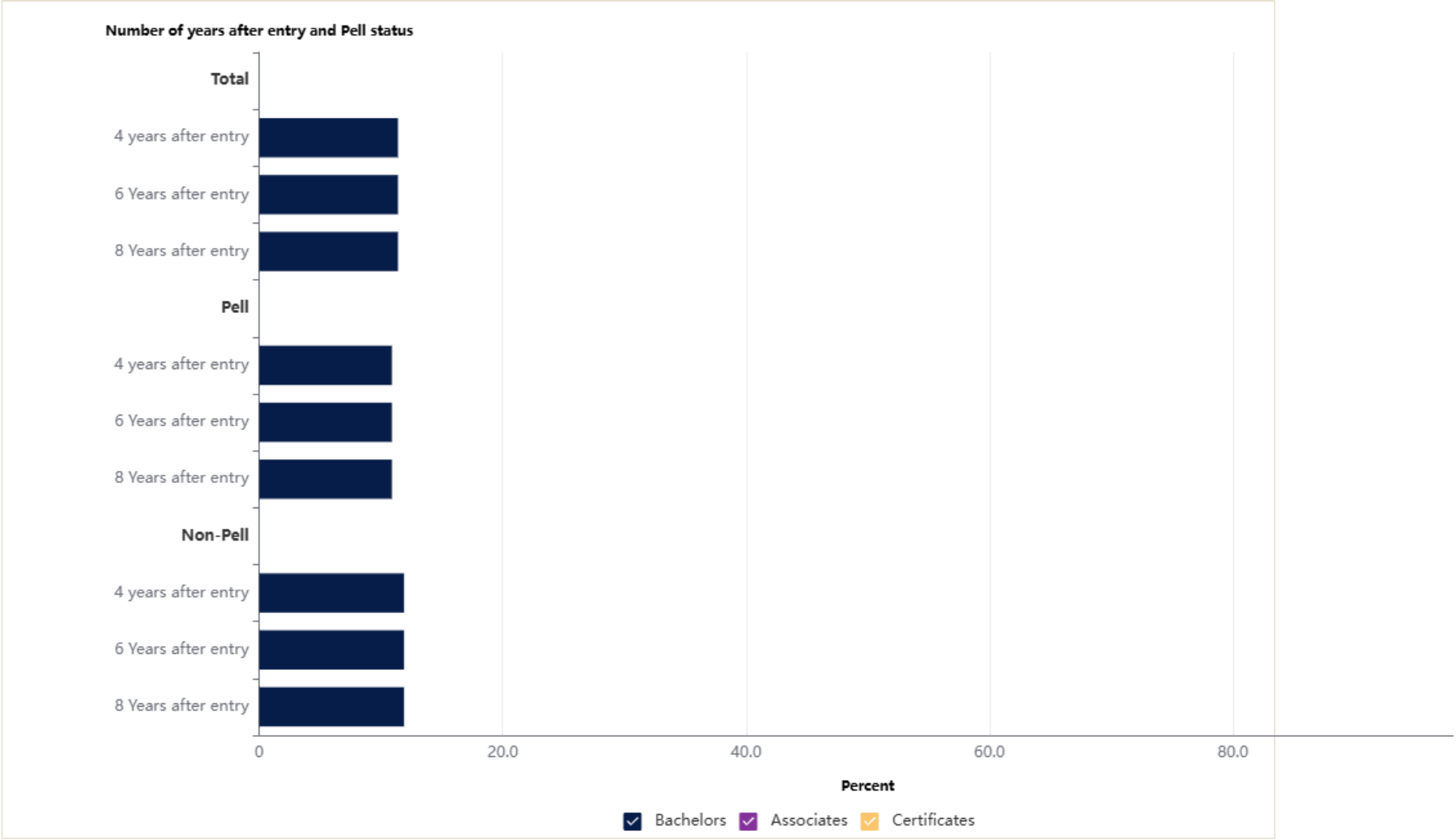
Percent of full-time, first-time entering students receiving an award at four, six, and eight years after entry, by type of award and Pell status, cohort year 2016–17

Percent of full-time, non-first-time entering students receiving an award at four, six, and eight years after entry, by type of award and Pell status, cohort year 2016–17

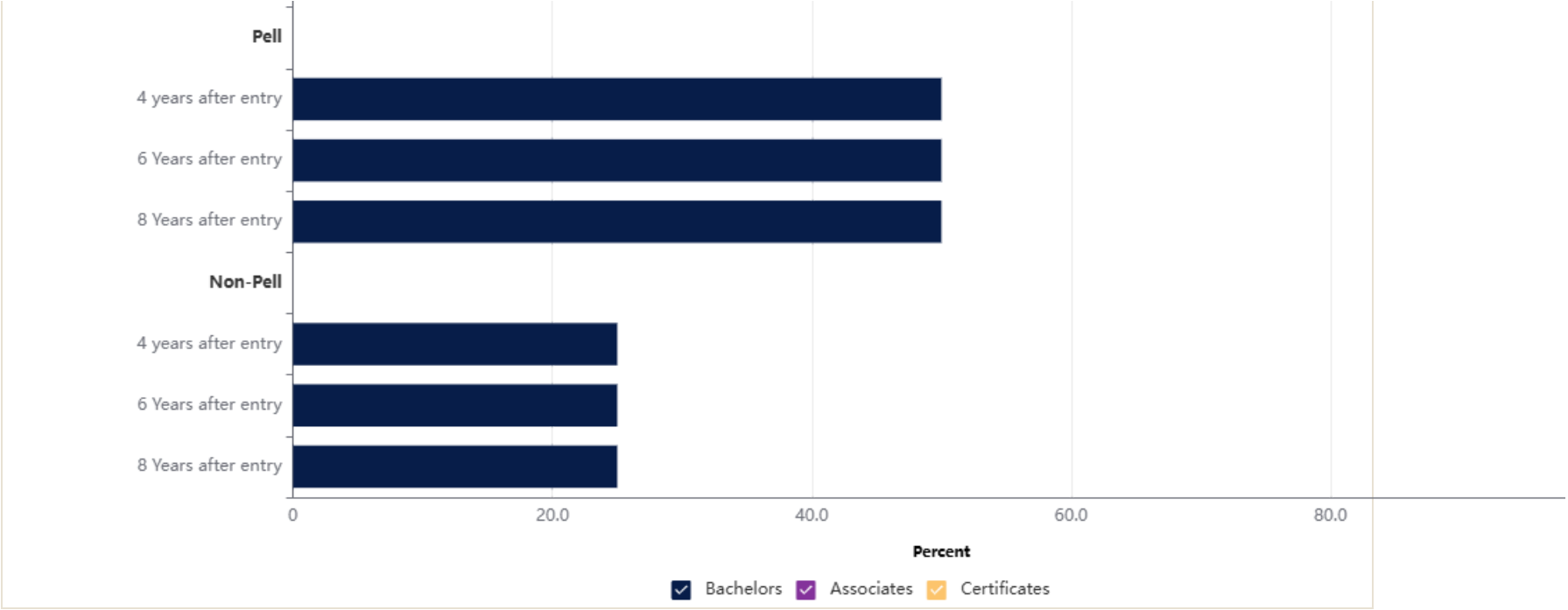
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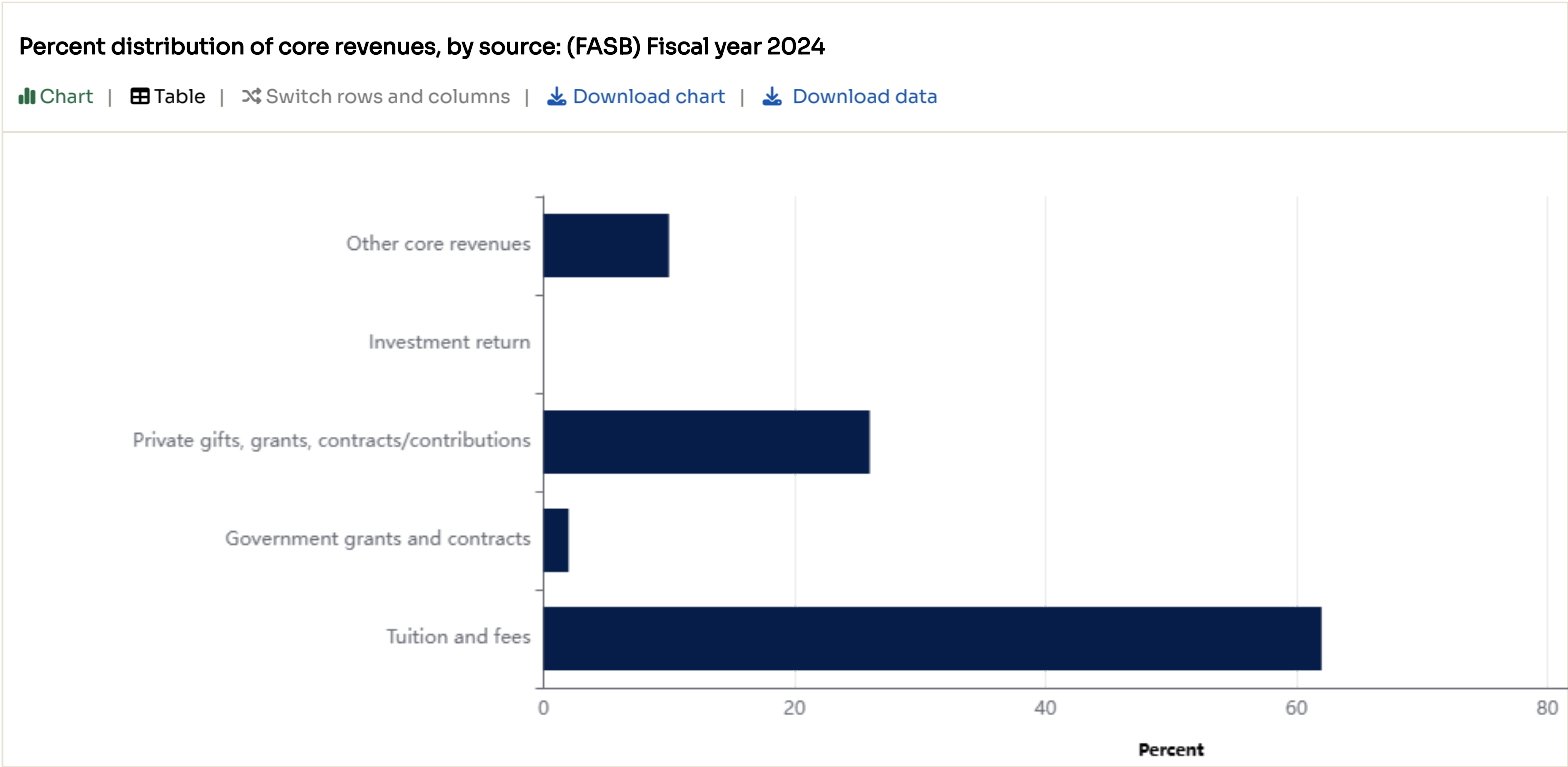
Percent of part-time, non-first-time entering students receiving an award at four, six, and eight years after entry, by type of award and Pell status, cohort year 2016–17

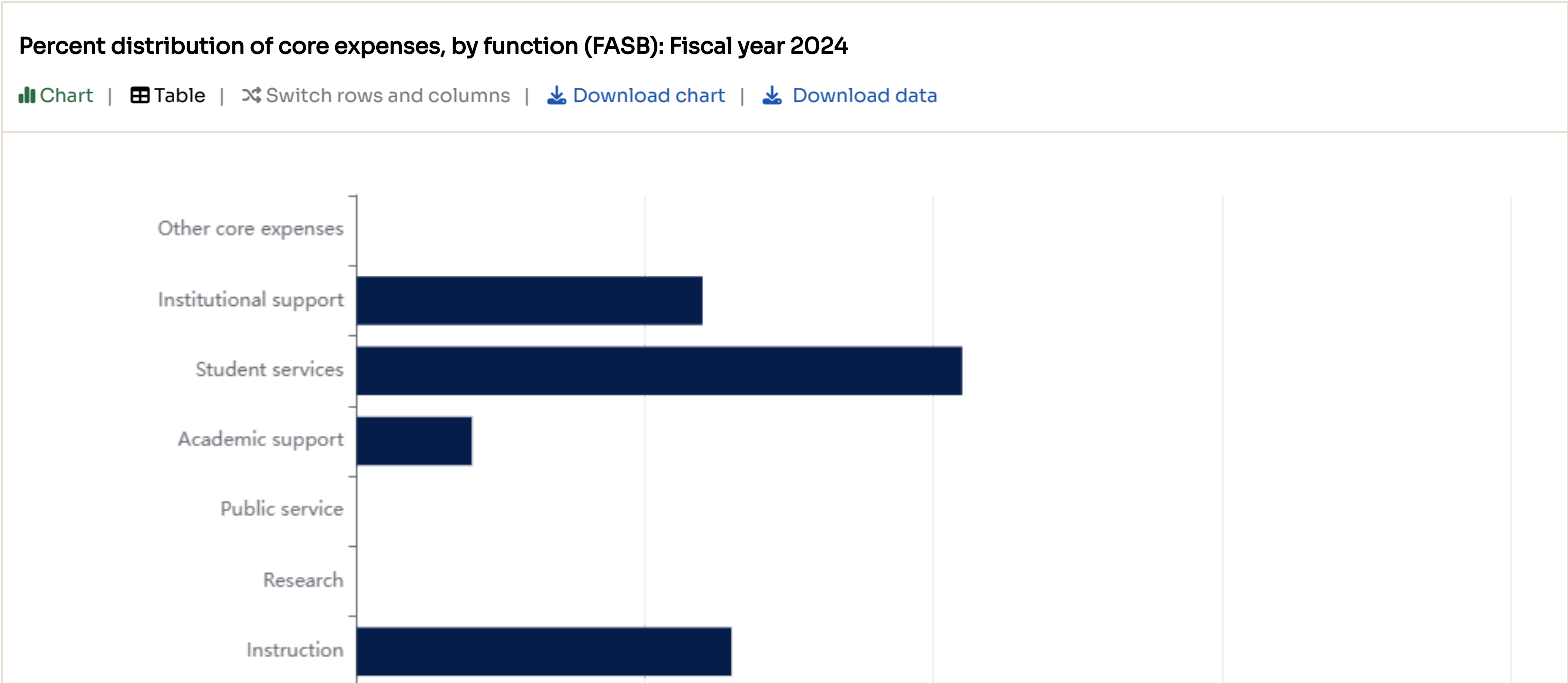

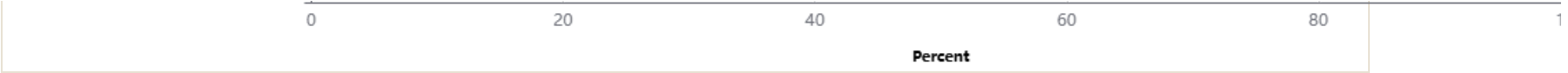


Core revenues per FTE enrollment, by source (FASB): Fiscal year 2024

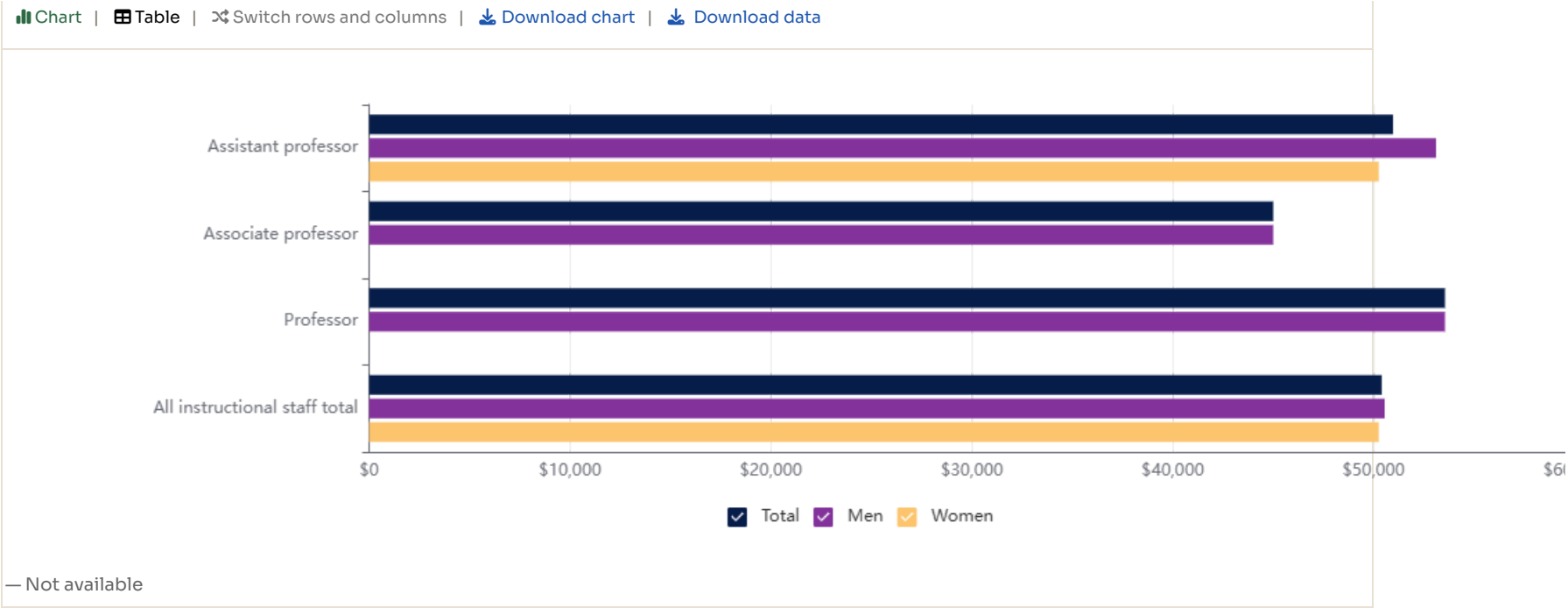

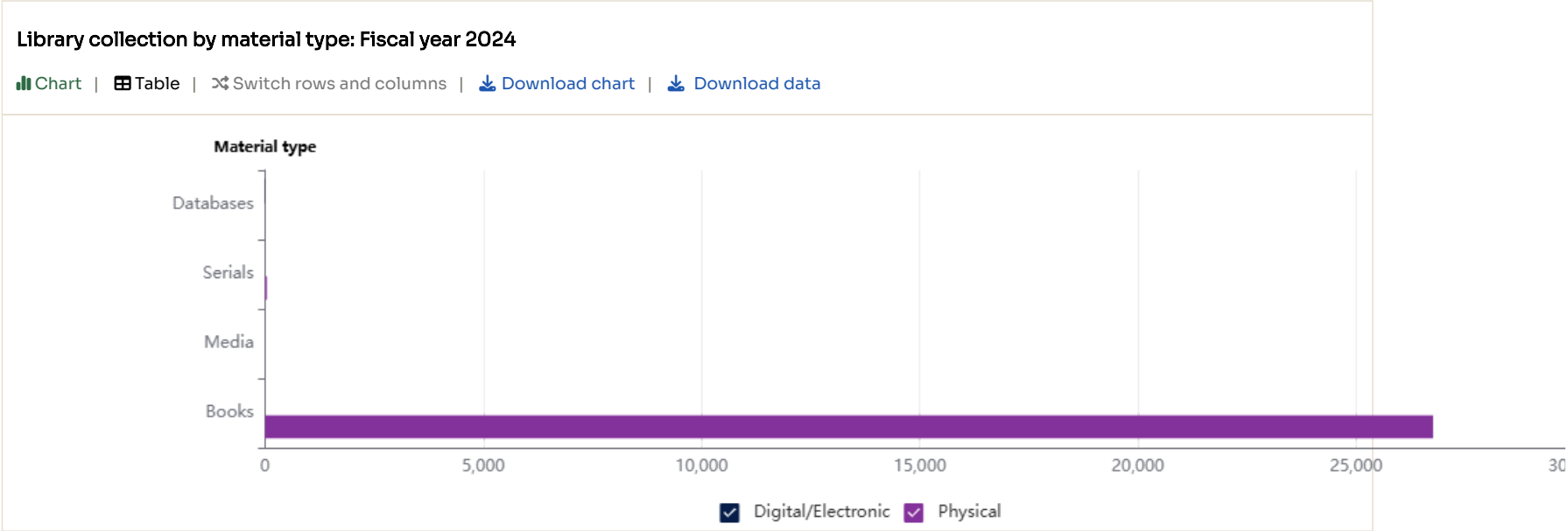
